Maybe you feel like stretching your legs a bit after two days of cycling? If wandering along lake shores is not quite enough, how about walking part of one of Southlands' Great Walks? The Kepler Track to Luxmore hut or summit is well worth considering.

Doubtful Sound Day Trip



Experience the spectacular, remote wilderness of Doubtful Sound on our guided day trip. Journey across Lake Manapouri, over the breathtaking Wilmot Pass and into the heart of Fiordland National Park. This is a must-do for nature lovers and explorers alike.

- Duration: 8+ hours
- Start with a cruise across Lake Manapouri, followed by a coach trip over the epic Wilmot Pass through Fiordland's rainforest and into the Sound
- A 3-hour cruise through the waterways of Doubtful Sound
- Cruise onboard the Patea Explorer (or similar ship)
- Commentary by a knowledgeable Skipper and Nature Guide
- Wildlife viewing, including dolphins, fur seals and even occasionally penguins
- Picnic lunches available for purchase from Manapouri Café
- Snacks and drinks available for purchase (cash only onboard)

Te Anau Glowworm Caves



Experience a mysterious underground world with a guided cave tour past the rushing water of an underground stream before drifting in silent darkness beneath the luminous shimmer of hundreds of glowworms.

Your trip to the Te Anau Glowworm Caves begins with a cruise to the western shores of Lake Te Anau on a purpose-built scenic cruise vessel.

At the entry to the caves at Cavern House, view the informative displays and learn about this geological wonder before you join your guide underground. On the tour of the caves, the friendly guides will point out the highlights and share their knowledge of the caves and its history.

This underground world is astonishingly beautiful. By geological standards, the caves are very young (12,000 years) and are still being carved out by the force of the river that flows through them. The result is a twisting network of limestone passages filled with sculpted rock, whirlpools and a roaring underground waterfall.

Deep inside the caves, beyond the roar of the water, you will be taken by small boat into a silent hidden grotto inhabited by hundreds of glowworms, unique to New Zealand. In the subterranean darkness, they produce a glittering display that is nothing short of extraordinary.

Water taxi to go on Kepler Track Day Walk



Access Te Anau's best day walk: Luxmore Summit Challenge 7-8 hrs / 26 km return / 928 m elevation change

The Water Taxi departs the Te Anau Lakefront to Brod Bay at 8:30am and returns from Brod Bay at 4:30pm

Price per person for return trip: \$ 70

Please note:

Even though you could start and end your day walk on the Kepler Track from the shores of Lake Te Anau, please be aware this adds an extra 1.5 hour to/from Brod Bay each way.

If you choose to take the 15 mins water taxi trip each way - which we highly recommend - you will start and end your day's hike at Brod Bay, ie save about 3 hours.

The Mt Luxmore Walk on the Kepler Track is not 'a walk in the park'.

The return walk from Brod Bay to Luxmore Hut takes about 5-6 hours (16.5km), from Brod Bay to the summit about 7-8 hours return (26 km). It is a steep and steady climb and good fitness is required. Be prepared for wind and rain in an open alpine environment. On good days there are fabulous views from the top at 1472m over the South Fiord that make it definitely worthwhile.

Other options at no cost and with no need to pre-book:

- take your bike and cycle around Te Anau, or to Manapouri and back
- take your bike and cycle to the Manapouri end of the Kepler Track and enjoy a two to three-hour easy walk
